

Top Tips – Return to school



Any period of transition, including returning to school, can cause anxiety so careful preparation will be needed to help children manage this change.

Involve children in the process and arrangements, including details that might seem trivial, such as:

- which room they'll go to first
- what time they'll go there
- how long they'll be there
- why they'll be there
- what will happen next.
- A visual timetable may help.

What are Social Stories?

Social stories[™] were created by Carol Gray in 1991. They describe an activity, situation or event and explain what to expect within that situation and why. Ideally social stories should be introduced before the event, when the child is feeling calm and relaxed. Depending on your child's understanding of language, social stories may include photos, symbols, and/or just words. Reading the social story regularly will help reinforce the message and hopefully support the child's understanding.
